

New on-line support group for gynaecological cancer

New On-line Support Group

A new online support group has been developed by the Cancer Council for women with gynaecological cancers. This special service is facilitated by women who have experienced a gynae cancer and is staffed by Cancer Council nurses. The on-line support group is held every Thursday from 2pm –3pm and can be accessed online from anywhere. Women can access the group by first registering with the Cancer Council, at which point they will be provided with a password. The aim of the support group is to provide a safe and confidential environment for women who have, or have had, a gynae cancer and are looking for support and / or, wish to support others going through a similar experience.

This is an exciting new service and one which aims to help provide an additional and anonymous means of support for women with gynaecological cancers. Women who have recently been diagnosed, are undergoing treatment or, who are post-treatment, are encouraged to participate, with the aim of facilitating sharing and support for other women.
