

Coming off Psychiatric Drugs

In the new publication edited by Peter Lehmann 28 people from New Zealand, Australian, Austria, Belgium, Denmark, England Germany, Hungary, Japan, the Netherlands, Serbia & Montenegro, Sweden, Switzerland and the USA write about their experiences of withdrawal.

Millions of people are taking psychiatric drugs like Haloperidol, Prozac, Zyprexa or Risperidone. To them, the detailed accounts of how others came off these substances without once again ending up in the doctors office are of fundamental interest.

Also in the book, eight professionals working in psychotherapy, medicine, psychiatry, social work, natural healing and even in a runaway house, report on how they helped in the withdrawal process.
